Twenty years ago the crushed limestone Cedar Valley Trail extended up to Waterloo, the crushed limestone Sac and Fox Trail served lucky SE side neighborhoods, the grassy Grant Wood Trail was in its infancy and the 3 miles of the Cedar River Trail was the only paved trail in the area. Flash forward 20 years and now we have 100+ miles of hard surface trails, 54 miles of grass trails and 17 miles of limestone trails.
